NEW BUSINESS

Southern Woodlands Reservation (Town of Oak Bluffs)

The Commission reviewed bids received for the razing of the former staff workshop here, which was rendered unneeded by the purchase of 40-44 Meetinghouse Way in Edgartown, listed here in descending order by price: (1.) Charles Stutler Construction, dated February 27, 2025, \$34,284.22; (2.) John Keene Excavation, dated February 27, 2025, \$25,000; and (3.) CG Junk Disposal, dated February 20, 2025, \$16,084.

Mr. Kisiel reported that the town of Oak Bluffs requires a construction supervisor's license for such work, which CG Junk Disposal does not have; he therefore recommended that the Commission award the project to John Keene Excavation, as next lowest bidder.

After discussion and by a motion made and seconded, the Commission voted unanimously in a roll call vote to award the project to John Keene Excavation.
